Overview

Development is minimal, with no public charging stations, though private initiatives and renewable energy projects signal potential. Opportunities lie in leveraging Angola's hydropower and solar potential, international partnerships, and its strategic role in regional trade. Angola's national oil company, Sonangol, has announced plans to deploy more than 100 Electric Vehicle Charging Points (EVCP) across the country by 2028, reinforcing its commitment to the nation's energy transition strategy. The initiative was announced at a Sonangol-sponsored workshop ahead of the Angola Oil & Gas 2025 Conference and Exhibition.

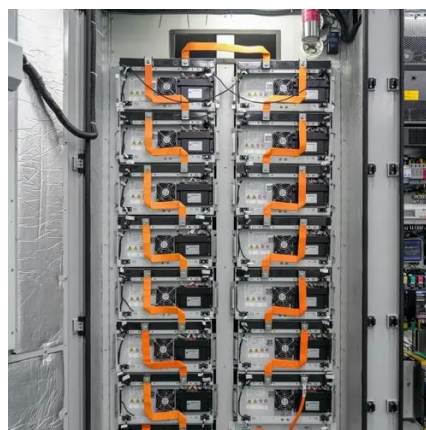
