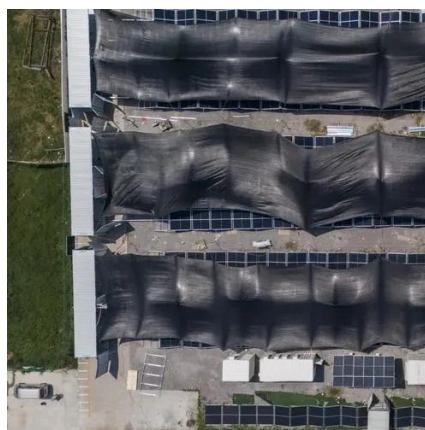


Total Streamflow Variation for the Upper Catchment of Bosten Lake ...
