The Paris Agreement of 2015 sets out a global framework to limit global warming to well below 2°C, preferably to 1.5°C (degrees Celsius), compared to pre-industrial levels. Therefore, Serbia is at greater risk of extreme weather conditions, droughts, wildfires, floods, and storms. The lack of greenery combined with high building density and materials such as concrete, asphalt, metal, and glass, which absorb a large amount of heat, and green infrastructure and climate change's impact on the urban environment. This shift is putting immense pressure on farmers and urban areas alike.

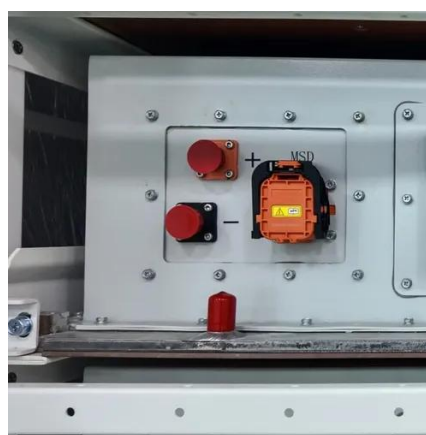

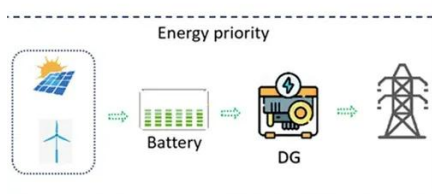
