The country has no formal landline telephone network, and telecommunications services are provided through satellite and mobile communications networks. Various large international mobile phone providers are present in the country. The oldest and once most popular newspaper, Juba Monitor, was suspended in April 2022 over disputes about legal ownership, illustrating the precarious nature of print media in the country.
