Developed by Africa REN, the €40 million project connects directly to national utility Senelec's network, providing critical stability and backup power during outages for millions of consumers. 5 MWp solar power plants located 145 km from Dakar. In operation since November 2017. The Ten Merina project consists of the design, construction, financing, operation and maintenance of a 29.5 MW solar power plant and the construction of a 3-km transmission line on behalf of the client Senelec. The vertically integrated and state-owned electric utility, SENELEC, maintains a monopoly in transmission and distribution (outside certain rural zones where private concessions are allowed) and is the main counterpart to IPPs for power purchase agreements (PPAs). 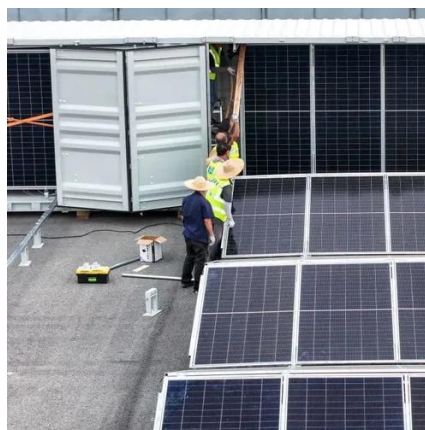

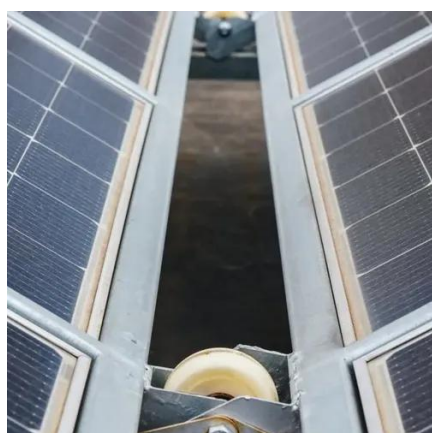
