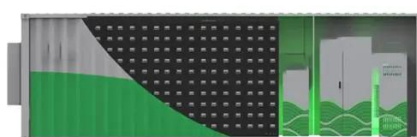

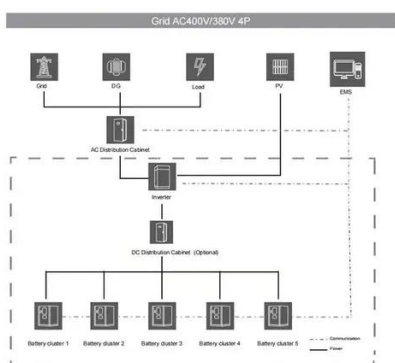

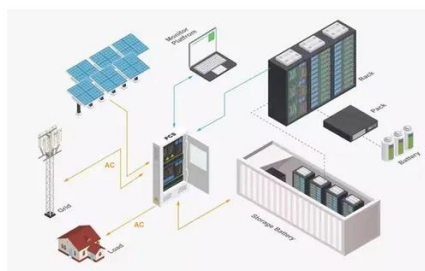
Energy in Senegal

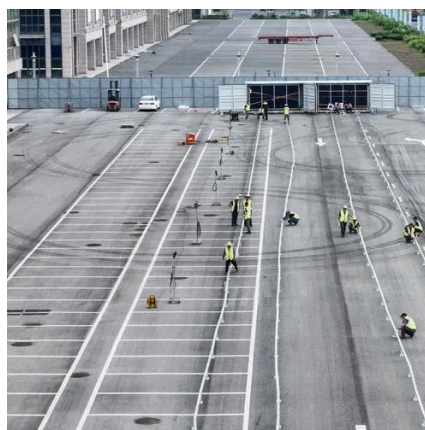
