Overview

Moldova's pro-Russia breakaway region of Transnistria is grappling with an energy crisis after Russia cut off gas shipments to the country at the New Year, leaving residents without reliable gas and electricity in the middle of winter. It generated most of Moldova 's electricity needs for decades, and ran historically on natural gas supplied by Russia to Transnistria for free. There is about a 30% energy deficit, or 65 megawatts (MW), as residents of. For more than three decades (1992-2022), Transnistria has defied geopolitical gravity. Historically, its survival has depended on a strategic relationship with Russia, which provided military, intelligence, political, economic, and energy support.
