



What can wind blades be used for





Overview

Options for reusing end-of-life turbine blades include animal-feeding troughs, bus shelters, farm partitions, construction materials for housing, public furniture, thermal insulation, and wave attenuators. The power of the wind is one of the most widely used renewable energy resources, going back to the earliest known windmills in Persia, over 1,000 years ago. Today, wind power has come a long way. We have upgraded from windmills, which were literally wind-powered mills for processing grain, to wind. However, old wind turbine blades often end up in landfills due to their non-biodegradable nature. Between 85 and 95 of a turbine's materials can be easily recycled, but the blades are made of fiberglass. Unfortunately, the scale of this issue will. Wind energy provides a cleaner alternative to fossil fuels, yet it brings its own environmental challenge: the disposal of retired turbine blades. With growing demand for wind turbine blade recycling, researchers and industry stakeholders are pioneering sustainable ways to transform this waste. These are excellent uses of these used fiberglass structures because they will last as long as concrete, probably have more sound deadening capacity, are lighter weight and therefore easier to install, and have a much smaller carbon footprint than making new cement or steel to make these sound.

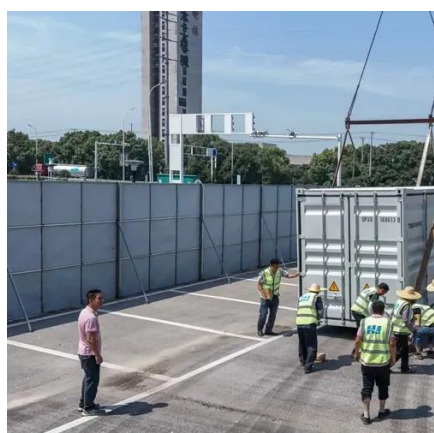
